UPCOMING EVENTS INFORMATION

- **Nighthawk Regional IDPA Championship is coming up on August 6th!** On Saturday August 6 the IDPA annual event will be held. Beginning on Monday August 1 starting with bay 10 all the pistol bays will be progressively closed to set-up the stages. Eventually only the rifle range will be open for use. Stage tear down should begin Sunday, August 7.
- **500-yard Range, Sunday August 7th** the 500-yard Range is open to members only to sight in a scope, test loads, or just shoot for personal practice. The shooting will start at 11:00 A.M. and go until we are out of ammo or tired of shooting by 4:00 P.M. This is not a competition but an opportunity to see what your gun does at 500 yards. There will be someone in the pits pulling a target for each shooter for 45 minutes, then we swap, and the shooter goes to the pits and the target pullers come to the firing line to shoot for 45 minutes. We rotate several times. Mike Maurer 812-305-2767.
- **The Evansville Police Department** is hoisting the New Recruit Academy training beginning on Tuesday, August 9, 10, 11, 12 from 7:00 AM until 5:00 PM. They normally use only bay# 3. However due to the high turnover of Police Officers and new recruits to train we are allowing them to use Bays #3 and #4. They will resume training on the 15, 30 & 31.
- **The Steel Challenge** event on Sunday, August 14 will use additional bays than normal until 3:00 PM. They will use bays 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 10. Bays 4 and 9 are open
- **Sub Gun Match, Sunday August 21st** on Bay 1, shooting starts at 12:00 noon. Pistol caliber sub-Guns only. We shoot paper and steel targets at 25 yards. Bring yours or come out to watch. Mike Maurer 812-305-2767.
- **Military Rifle Match, Saturday August 27th** at 12:00 noon, maybe if the work crew does not go over on time, on Bay 4. Three different class guns for three matches. An M1 Garand only match, an M1 30 caliber Carbine only match, and any bolt action military rifle with iron sights match. Shoot one, two or all three guns. Targets are paper bullseyes at 25 yards, 50 yards, 75 yards, and 100 yards. Best "score / timed" (he who shoots the bestest the fastest) wins each match. The entry fee is \$1.00 per rifle. The winner of each class takes the pot for each class. Mike Maurer 812-305-2767

It doesn't define what an assault weapon is, so this could include pistols. Emphasis should be placed to contact Senator Todd Young as he voted for the previous bill that legalized red flag laws.
