FROM THE RANGE OFFICER, FRANK FINDLEY

DO NOT DUMP YOUR PERSONAL TRASH AT THE RANGE

There have been several reports of people dumping personal trash at the range. This is inappropriate and leads to our trash bins being overfilled and range trash not being able to be removed.

Also, we had another incident of beer bottles being dumped at the range. This gives the false impression that alcoholic beverages are allowed on the range. The use of alcohol while at the range will not be tolerated and shall be grounds for immediate ejection from the range facility and further disciplinary action including expulsion from the club.

WARRICK FIRE BAN LIFTED

The previously reported county ban on fires has been lifted. This means that tracers and incendiary rounds can once again be used on the range. But please remember that you are responsible for any damage caused using these rounds should a fire result. Please have a fire mitigation plan in mind when using these types of rounds.

DO NOT SHOOT THE WILDLIFE

A shot skunk was found on the range. Please remember that killing wildlife is prohibited. This includes an absolute prohibition against hunting on range property. If you see wildlife downrange, take efforts to protect it from being shot including using the 'Cease Firing' line command. This is especially important going into fall as we often see an increase of deer walking on the property.

AN IMPORTANT LESSON – BE COUNSCIOUS OF FINGER/TRIGGER DISCIPLINE WHEN HOLSTERING

An unnamed male student had a “negligent discharge” of his gun while he was re-holstering it, Red River Range posted on Facebook.

In our safety briefings we stress the fundamental rules of gun safety. This includes **ALWAYS Keep Your Finger Off the Trigger Until Ready to Shoot**. A best practice is to keep your finger off the trigger and along the frame of the firearm anytime your sights are not on the target. One time to pay particular attention is when holstering a handgun. If the finger is still on the trigger, the holster can push the finger against the trigger resulting in a negligent discharge and a likely injury.

MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILY ARE INVITED TO ATTEND OUR SAFETY BRIEFINGS

Safety briefings covering fundamental gun safety, range rules, and range etiquette are held monthly for new members. But existing members including family are always welcome. The briefings run 1.5 hours and are followed by a brief range tour. Spouses who attend a safety briefing are eligible to receive their own gate card for a one-time \$10 fee.
