## **FROM THE RANGE OFFICER, FRANK FINDLEY**

### **PLEASE READ: CHANGES TO RANGE RULES ARE NOW IN EFFECT!**

The Red Brush Board of Directors have approved several changes to the range rules to take immediate effect. Most of the changes are to clarify wording regarding the proper handling of handguns and long guns when not on the firing line. Other changes are to align our wording of the Fundamental Rules of Gun Safety with the latest industry standard version released by the NRA. The complete updated range rules are [now available on our website](#).

**Please immediately review the updated Section 10 (all) and Section 13 (subsections B & C)** as they address basic gun handling:

#### **Section 10. Gun Handling and Shooting Rules**

- A. For the protection of all members and guest, always follow and practice all gun safety rules, especially these three fundamental rules:
1. Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction. A safe direction is down range, up in the air, toward the ground facing away from people including you.
  2. Always keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot. Ready to shoot best practice is to place your finger on the trigger after you have your gun's sights aligned with your target.
  3. Always keep the gun unloaded until you are ready to use. Unloaded condition for the range means that all ammunition has been verified to be removed from the gun and the action is locked open (if locking open is practical). This includes completely removing easily detachable magazines. All rounds must be removed from fixed magazines and revolver cylinders. Black-powder firearms must have no ball or powder in chamber, and for percussion guns, the caps must be removed.

Loading or unloading a gun on the range anywhere other than the firing line is prohibited.

Exceptional care must be taken when loaded guns are brought to the range. Only bring/remove them from the firing line when the bay is "hot" (see section 11. Range Commands).

Loaded handguns may be carried on range property but must be safely secured. Loaded handguns must be safely secured unless you have a position on a firing line and the line is "hot".

Loaded long guns brought to the range to shoot must be directly transported between the vehicle and the firing line during the first opportune "hot" period. Loaded long guns may not be carried on range property except to directly transport them between the vehicle and the firing line. When transporting a loaded long gun to the firing line, be sure to keep the muzzle pointed up until on the firing line where it can then safely be pointed down range towards the back berm.

#### **Section 13. Universal Range Rules**

- B. Do not leave a loaded gun unattended on the firing line. Red Brush encourages the use of chamber flags as an additional visible indicator that a gun is in an unloaded condition.
- C. Members are allowed to exercise (jog, walk, do calisthenics, etc.) on Red Brush property, but must do so in a way which does not interfere with shooting on the bays or block traffic. Shooting accessories such as vests and carriers can be worn when exercising. Handguns may be carried but must be safely secured. Long guns may not be carried when exercising.
