FROM THE RANGE OFFICER, FRANK FINDLEY

IMPORTANT – THE 500 YARD BAY IS ONLY OPEN DURING DESIGNATED TIMES ON CALENDAR!

We had a very dangerous situation at the range this past week. During a time when the 500-yard bay was closed, a member and a guest fired rounds from its firing line. While doing this, another member was on the 400-yard bay, which is downrange from the 500-yard firing line. While no one was injured, this was a serious close call.

In investigating this incident, the member reported not remembering that the 500-yard bay is closed except during designated times when range safety officers are present to oversee its use. Therefore, we are reminding the membership of this.

Section 19 C: Range Bay Specific Rules - The Rifle Ranges

"The 400-yard (East) rifle range is normally open to the members for informal shooting.

The 500-yard (west) rifle range is normally closed to members for informal shooting.

This is because of safety concerns. The firing line of the 500-yard range is behind and to the right of the 400 yard range. It would be unsafe to go down range on either rifle range if shooting were allowed on both ranges simultaneously, without coordinating Range Officers.

The 500-yard (West) rifle range is only opened for formal competition and for members use on scheduled and announced days. Check the range schedule and newsletter for the announcement of dates and times it is open."

To reinforce this rule, the Board of Directors has authorized the addition of a new gate to block access to the 500-yard firing line when the bay is closed.

REMINDER: PLEASE REVIEW RANGE RULES

Every member is responsible for reviewing the Range Rules and Regulations at least once a year. It is important to refresh our memories of rules, especially when substantive changes are made as was done in 2022. REMINDER: LEAVE THE BATHROOM HEATERS ON AND DOORS CLOSED
