NEW AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED)

Thanks to the efforts of Miki and Walter Estep, we have a new range AED. Our previous one had come to the end of its lifecycle, and it was getting difficult and expensive to obtain the disposable pads for it. The new one is being installed in the members room in the same cabinet location.

The new device is amazing. It requires no medical knowledge to use as it will walk the person through it. Miki recorded a little bit of the start-up cycle to give an idea as to just how easy it is to use:

22LR RIMFIRE CAN BE USED ON BAYS 1 & 2

Recently a member asked if 22 Long Rifle rimfire cartridges could be used on Bays 1 and 2 including on the plate racks. Per the range rules, yes, they can:

Section 19: Range Bay Specific Rules

A. Pistol Bays

Bay #1 and #2

Pistol bay #1 and #2 are restricted to handguns, carbines and rifles shooting pistol caliber ammunition. No high power bottle neck or straight wall cartridges designed for rifles are allowed even if fired from a pistol such as the Thompson Contender or an AR15 with a short barrel. It is the powerful cartridge that is banned not the gun shooting it.

The falling plate rack is designed for 22 rimfire and centerfire pistol calibers only. Examples of (not necessarily all) **approved cartridges for these bays**:

22 rimfire, 25 auto, 32 auto, 380 auto, 9MM, 38 Spl., 357 mag., 40 S&W, 10 MM, 41 mag., 44 mag., 45 Auto, 45 Colt, 50 action express, bottle neck cartridges designed for pistols such as 357 sig., 30 Mauser and Win. 44-40.

Every member is responsible for reviewing the Range Rules and Regulations at least once a year. It is important to refresh our memories of rules, especially when substantive changes are made as was done in 2022. REMINDER: LEAVE THE BATHROOM HEATERS ON AND DOORS CLOSED

As the weather turns cold, the bathroom heaters will be turned on to prevent the water lines from freezing. Please do not turn them off. Also, please take a minute to make sure the doors to the bathroom are closed. These electric heaters are expensive to run and cannot protect the water lines from freezing if a door is left open.

INDIANA #2 IN COUNTRY IN TERMS OF FIREARM PERMIT HOLDERS

A new study by the Crime Prevention Research Center shows that Indiana is now second in the country in percentage of the public with carry permits. And this is only a portion of those who can legally carry because of Indiana's recent change to a constitutional (permitless) carry state.

Here are some select findings from the study:

- Last year, the number of permit holders continued to grow by about 488,000. At 2.3% growth over 2021
- **8.5% of American adults have permits**. Outside of the restrictive states of California and New York, about 10.2% of adults have a permit.
- Alabama has the highest concealed carry rate 32.5%. **Indiana is second with 23.4%**, and Georgia is third with 15.5%.
- Six states now have over **1 million permit holders**: Alabama, Florida, Georgia, **Indiana**, Pennsylvania, and Texas. Florida is the top state with 2.57 million permits.
- In 2022, women made up 29.2% of permit holders in the 15 states that provide data by gender, an increase from the 28.3% last year. Seven states had data from 2012 to 2021/2022, and permit numbers grew 115.4% faster for women than for men.
