Ammo Recall Update: Winchester, Browning, and Herter's 9mm Luger 115 grain

Winchester has updated their recall of 9mm ammunition sold after March 24, 2021. The recall is extensive, now covering 60 lots in a variety of packaging. They recommend that owners of any of the company's 9 mm cartridges with 115-gr. full metal jacket bullets or 115-gr. jacketed hollow points immediately discontinue use until they consult the symbol and lot numbers printed on the box to determine if the loads are affected by the recall. NSSF Research on Firearm Use & Shooting Sports Participation – Great Info!

Ever wonder how many people participate in various shooting activities? In a recent webinar, the National Shooting Sports Foundation released some interesting research findings which can help inform us of people's interest in firearm activities. Here are some overview statistics:

- From 2009 to 2020, the number of sport shooters in the U.S. increased from 34 million to 56 million, a 65% increase!
- Last year, hunting with firearms increased from 17.2 million to 18.3 million participants. This is quite a turnaround in the number of active hunters.
- Despite many in-door ranges being closed for part of the year due to COVID, target shooting with live ammunition only dropped from 19.6 million to 19.5 million participants.
- Approximately 80% of new gun owners bought their firearms for home- and self-defense purposes (top two reasons cited). This represents 4+ million of the 5 million new owners. An encouraging finding was that most sought out training prior to and after their purchase.

We can be proud that Red Brush supports all these types of shooters by hosting training, leagues, and ready access to both short and long bays. With more than 4 out of every 10 households in the U.S. now reporting that they have a firearm, our safe environment provides a great community service.

However, this research also shows that only about 50% of gun owners are currently actively participating. So, we have a fantastic opportunity to get even more people out! It is simply a matter of understanding what type of shooting people want to do and what motivates them to join in. NSSF research provides some perspective on this too.

Here are the percent of sport shooters participating in several general types of shooting activity: Target shooting with a handgun (18.6%), Target Shooting with a rifle (16.8%), Sporting clays (7.2%), Skeet shooting (6.6%), Trap shooting (5.6%). Long-range shooting (4.6%), 3-gun shooting (2.2%).

They also looked at what motivates people to target shoot. Here are the percentage who cited each of the following reasons as “very important” to their decision to participate: To be with family or friends (63%), For sport and recreation (63%), For self defense (58%), To practice or prepare for hunting (54%), To mentor a new target shooter (45%), As part of their job (11%).

Net, a friendly invitation can go a long way to getting people out shooting! With holiday season on us, it is the perfect time to reach out to family and friends and invite them to the range. Red Brush does not set a limit on the number of guests you may bring at a time, except you may not occupy more than one bay at a time without prior approval. So, you can make it an event and invite a group. You just need to make sure that everyone understands and follows the rules. Bringing non-active gun owners to the range is an excellent New Year resolution!
