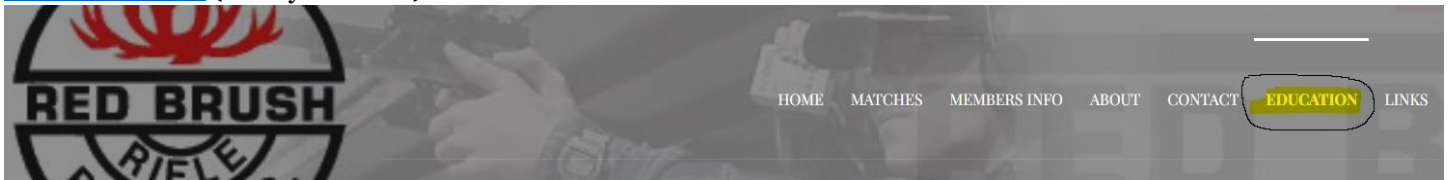

FROM THE RANGE OFFICER, FRANK FINDLEY

REMINDER: NO EXPLOSIVES – INCLUDING EXPLODING TARGETS – ALLOWED ON THE RANGE

With July 4th on the horizon thoughts of 'big booms' are on people's minds. Please remember that no explosives are allowed on the range without explicit board approval. This includes the use of exploding targets such as Tannerite®.

Recently we had a serious situation where an unexploded, mixed container of Tannerite was found at the range. Not only was this a violation of the no explosives rule, but it was also extremely dangerous. If you have any information regarding this, please contact the range officer.

REMINDER: AIR CONDITIONING AND DRINKING WATER AVAILABLE IN THE MEMBERS ROOM

With the outdoor temperatures increasing, heat exhaustion and other related conditions return as a threat. Remember that the members' room is air conditioned and water coolers with drinking water is provided there. If you should find that the water is running low, please let an officer know so that we can get the coolers resupplied.

The below chart details the symptoms of various heat related conditions and what actions to take.

HEAT-RELATED ILLNESSES

WHAT TO LOOK FOR

WHAT TO DO

HEAT STROKE

- High body temperature (103°F or higher)
 - Hot, red, dry, or damp skin
 - Fast, strong pulse
 - Headache
 - Dizziness
 - Nausea
 - Confusion
 - Losing consciousness (passing out)
- Call 911 right away-heat stroke is a medical emergency
 - Move the person to a cooler place
 - Help lower the person's temperature with cool cloths or a cool bath
 - Do not give the person anything to drink

HEAT EXHAUSTION

- Heavy sweating
 - Cold, pale, and clammy skin
 - Fast, weak pulse
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Muscle cramps
 - Tiredness or weakness
 - Dizziness
 - Headache
 - Fainting (passing out)
- Move to a cool place
 - Loosen your clothes
 - Put cool, wet cloths on your body or take a cool bath
 - Sip water
- Get medical help right away if:**
- You are throwing up
 - Your symptoms get worse
 - Your symptoms last longer than 1 hour

HEAT CRAMPS

- Heavy sweating during intense exercise
 - Muscle pain or spasms
- Stop physical activity and move to a cool place
 - Drink water or a sports drink
 - Wait for cramps to go away before you do any more physical activity
- Get medical help right away if:**
- Cramps last longer than 1 hour
 - You're on a low-sodium diet
 - You have heart problems

SUNBURN

- Painful, red, and warm skin
 - Blisters on the skin
- Stay out of the sun until your sunburn heals
 - Put cool cloths on sunburned areas or take a cool bath
 - Put moisturizing lotion on sunburned areas
 - Do not break blisters

HEAT RASH

- Red clusters of small blisters that look like pimples on the skin (usually on the neck, chest, groin, or in elbow creases)
- Stay in a cool, dry place
 - Keep the rash dry
 - Use powder (like baby powder) to soothe the rash



UPCOMING RANGE EVENTS INFORMATION

- Sunday, June 5th Military rifle Match at 12:00 noon on Bay 4. Three different class guns for three matches. An M1 Garand only match, an M1 30 caliber Carbine only match, and any bolt action military rifle with iron sights match. Shoot one, two or all three guns. Targets are paper bullseyes at 25 yards, 50 yards, 75 yards, and 100 yards. Best “score / timed” (he who shoots the bestest the fastest) wins each match. The entry fee is \$1.00 per rifle. The winner of each class takes the pot for each class. Mike Maurer 812-305-2767
- Saturday, June 11th the 500-yard Range is open to members only to sight in a scope, test loads, or just shoot for personal practice. The shooting will start at 11:00 A.M. and go until we are out of ammo or tired of shooting by 4:00 P.M. This is not a competition but an opportunity to see what your gun does at 500 yards. There will be someone in the pits pulling a target for each shooter for 45 minutes, then we swap and the shooter goes to the pits and the target pullers come to the firing line to shoot for 45 minutes.
