### FROM THE RANGE OFFICER, FRANK FINDLEY

### DO NOT USE RANGE BARRELS AS TARGETS, TARGET BACKERS, OR TARGET STANDS

We are still receiving reports of people using the blue and white barrels as target backers. So, we are including this notice again.

On several of the bays you will find plastic and metal barrels. These are props to be used as makeshift walls, obstacles, and tables. They should not be shot at. So please do not use them as targets, target backers, or knock-off target stands. Instead, use the provided A-Frame, U-Frame, and knock-off stands.

Also, there have been recent incidents where shooters did not use wooden slats in the A-Frame target stands but rather wedged the cardboard into crossbeam of the stand. Here is a picture of an example:

This can produce a dangerous situation as bullets can easily hit the crossbeam sending them in random directions, including back at the shooter. There definitely were signs of the crossbeam getting hit on this target stand.

# Project Appleseed Celebrates 17th Year at Red Brush!

It has been 17 years since Project Appleseed began hosting classes at Red Brush. The first shoot had 157 participants and made the news, not only in Evansville but across the country. Every year thousands of people wanting to become more proficient with their rifles come to an Appleseed shoot. There they are taught safe handling, steady shooting positions, sling usage, the six steps of firing a shot, natural point of aim, and other skills necessary to hit standard size targets out to 500 yards. All this is done in a family-friendly, all-ages-welcomed manner without a 'boot camp' attitude.

But even more important than the marksmanship training, participants are exposed to stories of our country's founders and the sacrifices they made on April 19, 1775 at Lexington and Concord. The events of this day set the colonies on a course to become the United States of America. This history, which once was a staple of grade, middle, and high school curriculum, is barely touched upon in public schools these days!
