FROM THE RANGE OFFICER, FRANK FINDLEY

WATCH FOR FARMING NEIGHBOR TO THE WEST OF THE 500 YARD BAY

When using the 400 and 500 yard bays, please be on the lookout for farming on the lot to the West of our fenced property. With harvesting time here, our neighbor will be in that field. Since we do not have a side berm along that Western side, when they are working South of our shooting lines, please call a cease-fire and unload your firearms.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER SHOOTING INCLUDING PUTTING BARRELS BACK

Once again, we have had members use barrels and target stands and not return them to their proper location when done. It is each member's responsibility to clean up their space after shooting. Ideally, each of us should strive to leave the range cleaner than when we found it. This includes sweeping up brass, bringing target stands back to the line, and disposing of refuse. On Bay 5, please return the barrels and target stands to along the side berms of the bay as per these photos:



REMINDER: DO NOT SHOOT ON THE 500-YARD BAY WHEN 400-YARD BAY IS OPEN

We recently had another close call when two members set up to shoot on the 500-yard firing line when the 400-yard bay was open and in-use. Luckily, they were stopped from shooting before those on the 400-yard bay were put in danger. A gate has been added to the 500-yard bay to remind members when that bay is closed. When the gate is closed, do not enter that area. If you see individuals on the 500-yard firing line when it is not open, please alert them that this is dangerous and not allowed.
