FROM THE RANGE OFFICER, FRANK FINDLEY

REMINDER: PLEASE DO NOT SHOOT ANIMALS ON RANGE PROPERTY

Wildlife is quite active on the range right now. Deer have been moving through regularly and a large hawk has been hunting the 400 and 500 yard bays. Please remember that hunting is not allowed on our property and killing the wildlife is prohibited. A ceasefire should be called whenever they are in danger of being hit.

MEMBER SHARES PERSONAL STORY OF A TUBE MAGAZINE CARTRIDGE EXPLOSION

Last month we mentioned the need to be careful when loading certain tube magazine rifles such as the classic Henry design. Releasing the tube follower on such rifles can lead to a cartridge explosion within the magazine tube. After reading the post, member and firearm instructor Doug Sprick reached out to share his own personal experience with such an explosion at Red Brush. Here is a summary of his experience (with a few additions for background information):

I had a similar issue with a Henry Rifle at Red Brush years ago. I use reloads and one went off in the loading tube when I let the tube load spring snap in place.

I had the rifle's butt on the ground with the tube opening facing outward and down range when it went off. All the forces were directed away from me and my friends at the time. Needless to say, the shooting day was ruined.

There were no injuries, as all the force went outwards away from me and I have a nice example of a 45LC round split with the bullet embedded in it. Would make a nice safety example for display. I had gunsmith Brian Cosby check the rifle out afterward and all was in good working order but realized more short comings in the Henry design. Still a fun rifle to shoot.

Upshot:

- 1. I lost concentration in what I was doing but I had the sense to keep all parts of the rifle pointed in a safe direction.
- 2. I have lost faith in Flat Nose Bullets and prefer hollow points in lever guns now, or the new Hornady FTX bullets. (Note: information on Hornady FTX Flex Tip bullets and Ammunition for lever action rifles can be found here: <u>https://www.hornady.com/ammunition/leverevolution#!/</u>).
- 3. Keep safety in mind at all times.

FORTRESS SAFE ANNOUNCES RECALL OF BIOMETRIC GUN SAFES DUE TO SERIOUS INJURY HAZARD AND RISK OF DEATH; ONE DEATH REPORTED

A defect has been found in the biometric locks on Fortress brand safes. This defect reportedly allows nonauthorized users to be granted access to the safe. In one instance, it is alleged in a lawsuit that a 12-year-old boy died from a firearm obtained from one of these safes because of the defect. These safes were sold at Bass Pro Shops, Cabela's, Scheel's, Sportsman's Guide, Optics Planet, Dick's Sporting Goods, Gander, Rural King, Lowe's, and other stores nationwide and online at Amazon.com and Ebay.com. If you have a Fortress Safe, you should immediately check the model to see if it is subject to recall.
