FROM THE RANGE OFFICER, FRANK FINDLEY

SIG SAUER AND HOSER MANUFACTURERS ISSUE SAFETY NOTICES ON HOLSTERS DESIGNED FOR LIGHT-BEARING PISTOLS

Sig Sauer and several holster manufacturers have issued safety bulletins concerning holsters designed to carry light equipped firearms. Due to the wide opening of these holsters to accommodate mounted lights, fingers and other items may be able to touch the trigger while the pistols are in the holster. This has reportedly led to several unintended discharges of the holstered pistols. In some instances, the issue may occur if a holster designed for a light-bearing pistol is used with a pistol that does not have a compatible light attached.

WINTER CLOTHING CAN MAKE MANIPULATING FIREARMS MORE DIFFICULT

With wintry weather comes layered clothing that can make firearms harder to use. Gloves can make it difficult to hold onto firearms and control trigger squeeze. Bulky coats can make it difficult to remove handguns from holsters and to properly shoulder long arms. Scarves and other loose items can get caught in firearm actions. Glasses can fog up lessening vision. So please be aware of these hazards and take your time to ensure safe handling.
