Lesson learned: it may be a good idea to close our ammo boxes when shooting thereby eliminating this one in a billion chance.

### Where to go in case of tornado

On July 30 Warrick County was hit by an EF-1 tornado. The path of this tornado went right to Red Brush Rifle Range (see below map) and we sustained some damage. This brings up a question, where should one go for shelter if caught in such a storm at the range? Indiana's Department of Homeland Security recommends going to an inner room away from doors, windows, and outer walls. Based on this, the most secure area accessible at the range is the women's restroom in the Webber Training Facility.



### Target Stands by Robert F. Adams



It is understood that at a gun range things are expected to get damaged. However, proper use of target stands will reduce the frequency of property damage. Below are some examples of misuse of the stands.





The stands with wood are for target knock-off, such as coke cans. They are not to have targets stapled to them. Under normal use with 22 rim-fire only the top board will need replacing most often. This bay only had one steel stand and that may be why this was used improperly. If you relocate the stands to other bays return them when finished. This damage was not caused by 22 rim-fire and appears intentional.



This cannot happen accidentally. High power cartridges used to shoot the leg many times. This deprives other members of their use.



This metal stand and four others are missing the pry open handle used to install the laths. These are very hard to remove or install. Placing your target high above the stand will reduce damage to the steel stand.

## APPLESEED, BEN SWARTZ

Our annual Known Distance Event this year will be on October 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>. Saturday will have instruction at 25 meters. Centerfire rifles are highly encouraged on Saturday. Sunday, we will move to the 500-yard bay to engage targets at distance. Centerfire rifles are mandatory for this portion of the shoot.

A “Known-Distance Appleseed” is a weekend-long program that teaches the secrets of shooting out to 400 yards, including target detection and ranging; measuring and compensating for wind; scopes and reticles; MOAs and mils, boxing your sights, battle-sight zero and come-ups, and much more.

Since this material requires previous exposure to the skills taught at an Appleseed, only students who have been to at least one Appleseed can attend a “KD Appleseed.” Experienced shooters will find that shooting successfully at “Rifleman distances” is a major confidence builder and an opportunity not to be missed!

## REVERE'S RIDERS, BEN SWARTZ

Revere's Riders – Carbine 1 & 2 – November 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup>

**Prerequisites:** Suggested—Rifle 125.

*If you have not attended Rifle 125, then you should be:*

- Able to reliably hit a 10" paper plate from the standing position out to 25 yards, kneeling at 50 yards, and prone at 100 yards
- Able to consistently hit a 3×5 index card at 15 yards while standing
- Familiar with basic operation of your carbine

*If you cannot meet the accuracy suggestion then you may be frustrated at carbine class and be better served learning the fundamentals of marksmanship at a Rifle 125 clinic.*

**Estimated Ammunition Required:** 250 rounds/day

This course is conducted as an NRA [America's Rifle Challenge](#) clinic. Students will learn modern defensive shooting skills on the AR platform. Attendees will experience shooting in multiple firing positions at varying distances. While this course is named for the common round fired by the AR-15 (".223 Remington") any safe semiautomatic carbine can be used.

All firing in this course will be within 200 yards with a focus on the close quarters environment from contact to 50 yards. You will get a workout with all the skills needed to run the carbine from 7-100 yards.

• Firing Stance: Standing	• Double Feed

• Zero rifles as required	• Carbine Trajectory and Zero Issues
• Situational Awareness and Scanning	• Barricades
• Rapid Magazine Changes (Tactical Reloads)	• Movement
• Short Range Marksmanship Techniques	• Use of the sling to support shooting stability
• Tailoring the five steps to firing each shot to the close quarters environment	• Special Subjects (most one-day clinics will cover only a few of these; two-day clinics will cover most or all)
• Controlled Pairs	• Kneeling Position
• Recoil Management	• Prone Position
• Clearing Malfunctions/Stoppages	• Natural Point of Aim
• Firing from retention	• Field Stripping & Cleaning the AR-15

Documentation to order ammo includes proof of U.S. citizenship and membership in a CMP Affiliated Club or Special Affiliate (see [https://thecmp.org/cmp\\_sales/eligibility-requirements/](https://thecmp.org/cmp_sales/eligibility-requirements/) for detailed information).

Customers placing a surplus ammo order through the CMP E-Store will not need to provide Form 2A (those individuals will check a box that states they are not a felon before completing their order). Customers that purchase surplus ammo in-person at our stores or at CMP events must provide Form 2A if they do not have one on file or if it's expired.

Please help us keep our sales running smoothly by updating your customer file before making a purchase on our E-Store. We appreciate your cooperation. Welcome back, shoppers!

## CMP SPECIAL NOTE

Effective June 26, 2024, customers are allowed to purchase up to six (6) bolt action rifles per year while supplies last. Current inventory of M1903 and M1917 rifles by grade is listed below. CMP also plans to release up to 1,000 Krag-Jorgensen rifles beginning in mid to late July. These have not been working so a grade break-out is currently unavailable.
