This event is for Red Brush Members, their family or A guest. Not open to the general public.

Food, snacks and drinks are free. The BBQ is catered by Marx BBQ. Food will be served starting between 5:30 and 6:00 PM. Beer will be served until it is gone or 8:00 PM. There are many free door prizes. This year including electronic hearing protection. Everyone attending gets a door prize ticket.

The auction activities will start at 6:30 PM

Doors will open at 5:00 PM for unloading your Merchandise. Members bring unwanted shooting sport related items to sell. Guns, gun parts, ammo, reloading supplies, dies, gun cabinets, knives, scopes, gun books, stocks, magazines, holsters, pouches, and military items are some of the articles that typically show up. Partial boxes of bullets and powder are also popular. Cheap stuff sales quickly --- somebody out there needs your scope cover, your clips and all those extra springs and gun screws. Sometimes there are free items.

Members always find some real good deals, so bring some cash. There is no commission. All we do is find a buyer for the seller. Don't worry, if you cannot use your bargain purchase, just bring it back next year to sell.

There are two ways your merchandise may be sold. Expensive items like firearms will be conducted by a live auction. The other is by a silent auction. Attached is a form for that. There will be copies of the form at the auction. Tag your items before you come with your name and if you have a minimum amount you will accept. The tables will be full of merchandise for sale. If you have multicable items of the same thing, on your form say how many available and put some under the table.

This event is paid for by your donations to Red Brush by purchasing Auction Night, Raffle Tickets.
